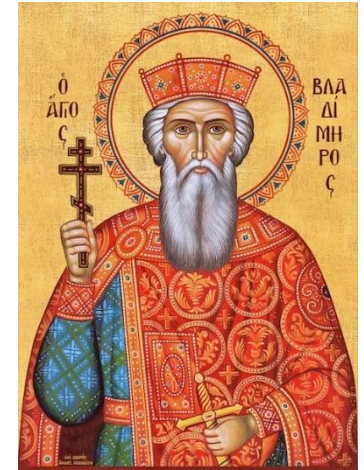

HISTORY OF A SAINT: *Vladimir the Great, Equal to the Apostles*
St. Vladimir the Great, was the Grand Duke [Prince] of the “Rus” at the time of his Baptism in 988 A.D. With his Baptism, he took the name “Basil”. He became the enlightener of the realm of the “Rus”, during the reign of the Emperor Basil II. Thus, he is given the title Equal to the Apostles. St. Vladimir died in 1016 A.D., after edifying a penitent life. He was laid to rest in the church he constructed in Kiev in honor of the Blessed Mother of God. The feast day for St. Vladimir the Great is on July 15.
