**TYPIKA-THE SERVICE OF HOLY COMMUNION WITHOUT A PRIEST** has been prepared for the use of deacons and faithful in the Byzantine Ruthenian Metropolitan church of Pittsburgh by the Intereparchial Commission for Sacred Liturgy. While Typica, or *Obidnitsa*, without holy communion has a regular place in the daily hours of the Divine Praises, it is to be noted that this service with holy communion and served only by a deacon is exceptional and for those emergency situations when a priest is not available to celebrate the Divine Liturgy. The deacon who is to conduct the service must have the permission of the bishop.

**What is Hell?**

Christianity, Judaism, Islam, Buddhism, and Hinduism all teach that there is a place of damnation: actions have consequences in the life to come!
